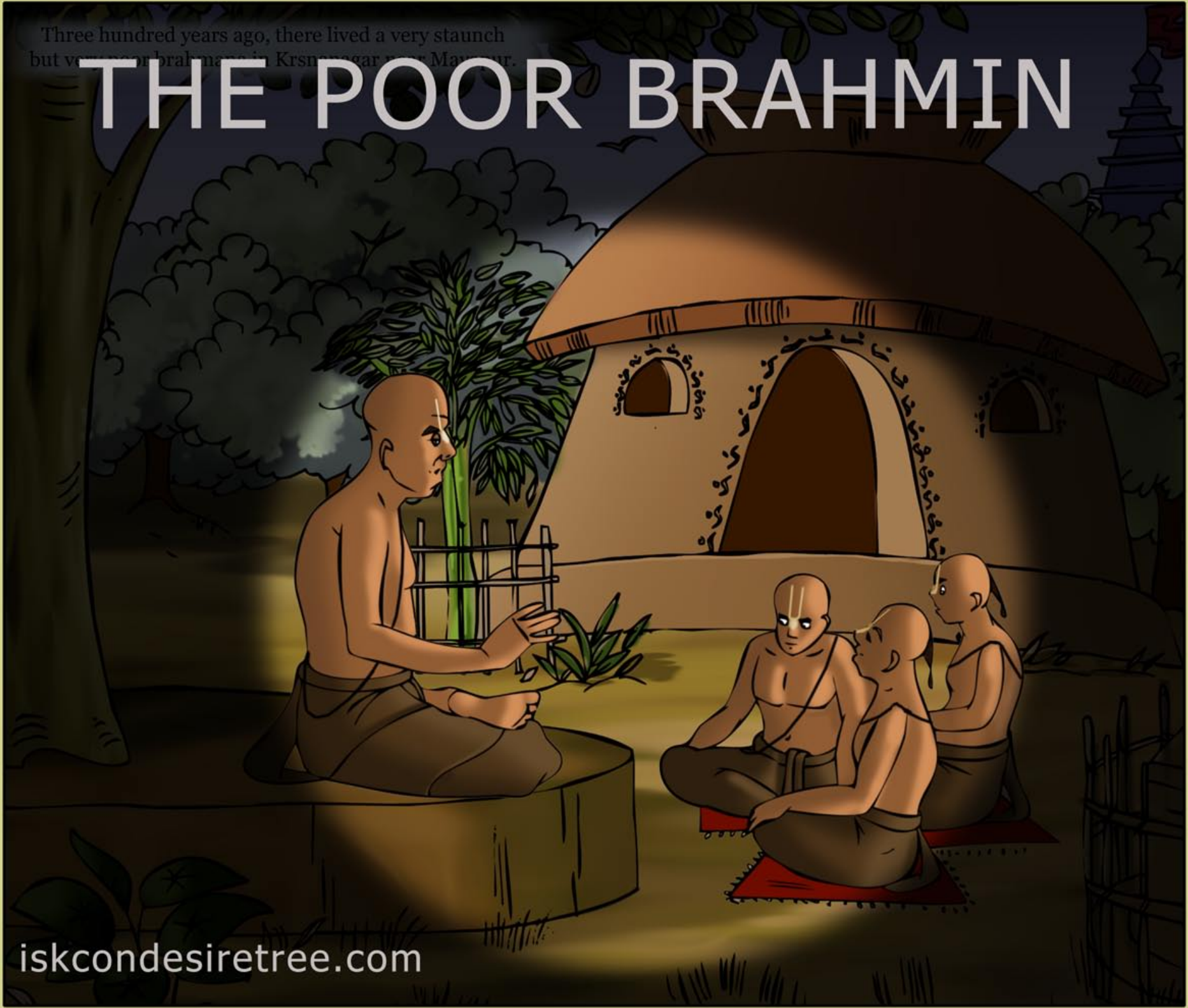


Three hundred years ago, there lived a very staunch

poverty-stricken




No I am not poverty-stricken.
