The village leader came to see the sadhu.




Namaste,

here.




I have

The villager bid farewell.





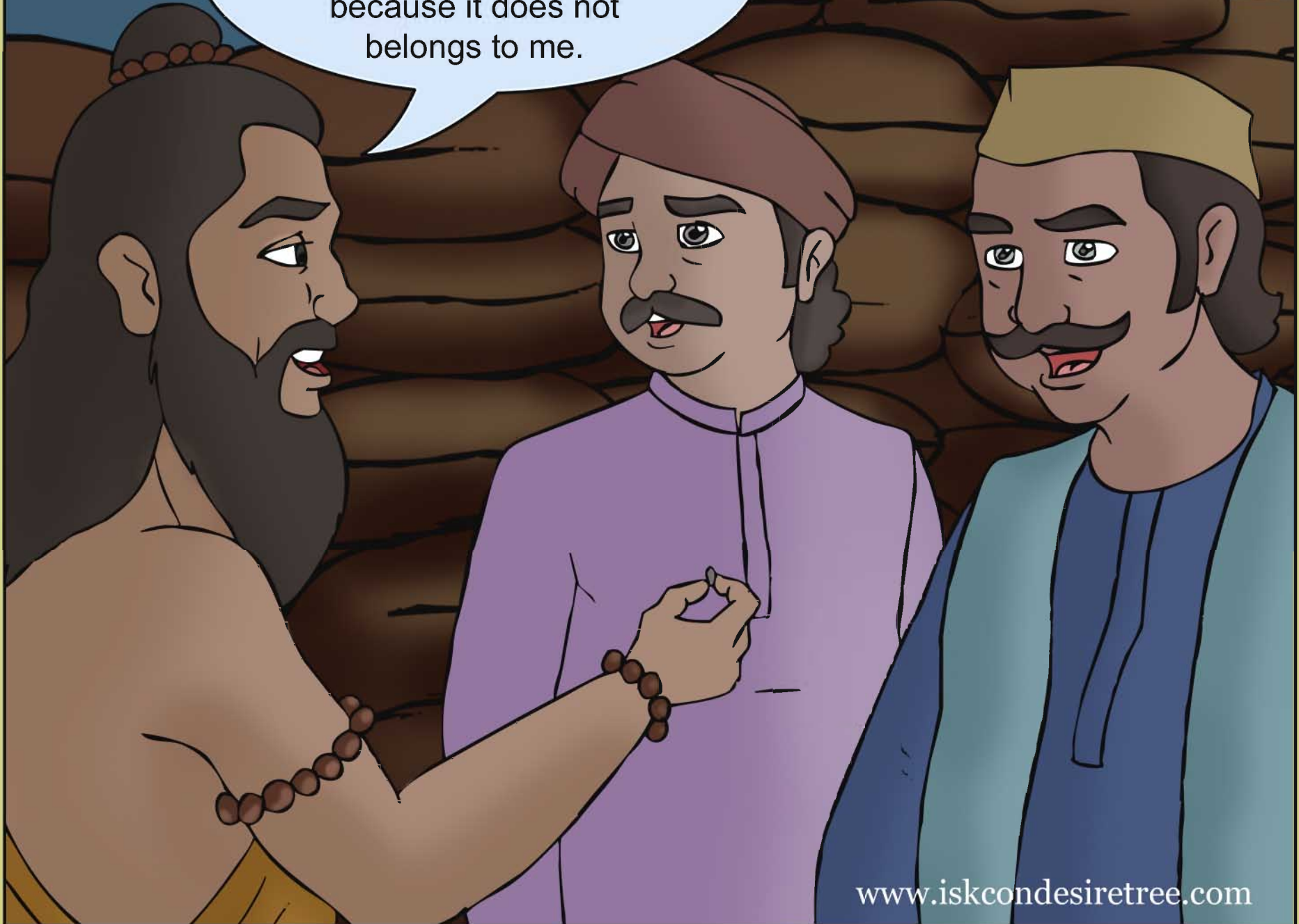
I should do something so that this villagers can have faith in me & thus I can escape with all the wealth

his head.




When I

the sadhu has stealed it.

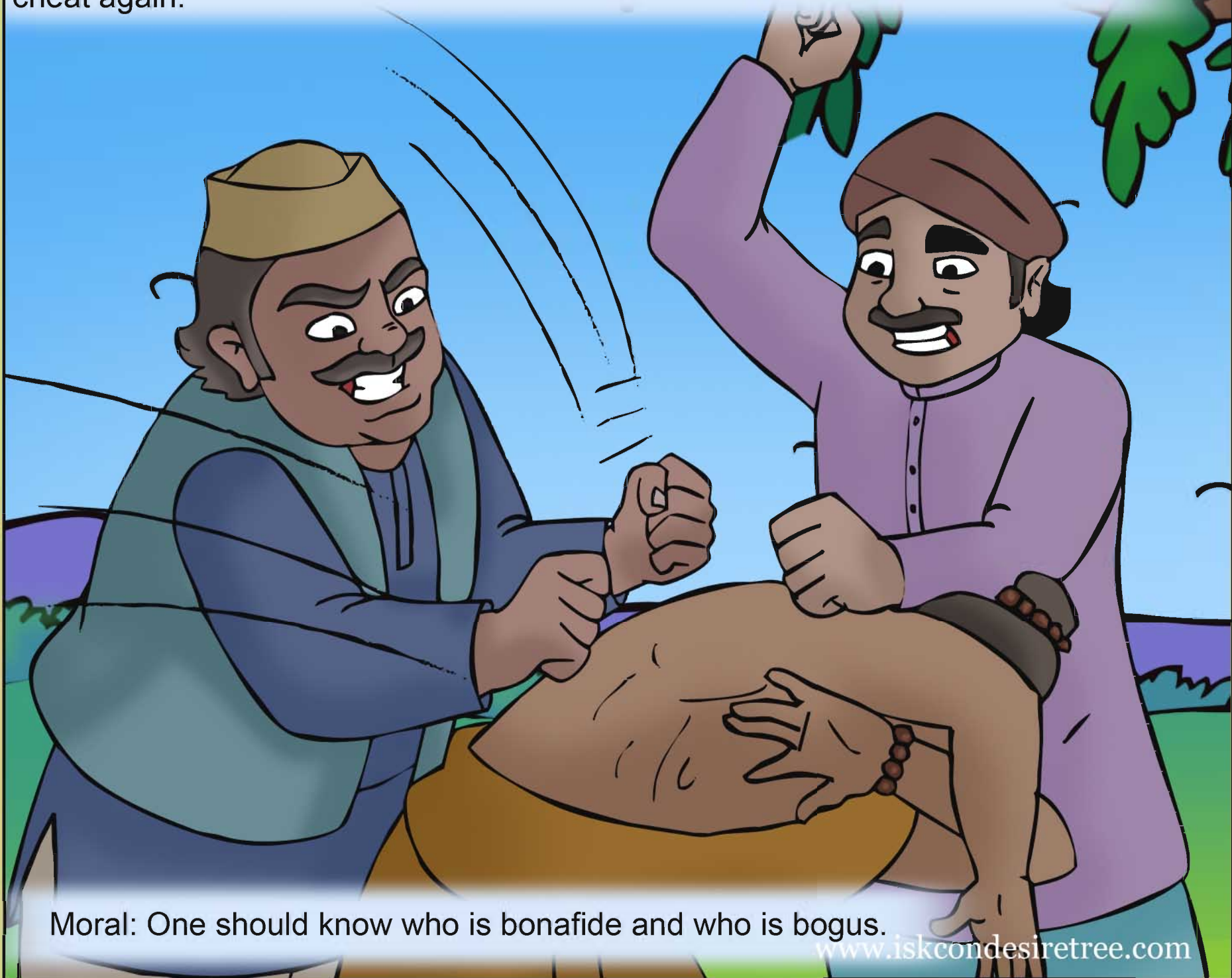
Let's go
